

Jason Mraz



Atlantic recording artist and San Diego-based troubadour Jason Mraz began performing in local coffee shops a little more than a decade ago and has since become an internationally renowned performer. His latest studio album, *We Sing. We Dance. We Steal Things.*, has been certified platinum or multi-platinum in 15 countries spanning four continents around the world.

We Sing. We Dance. We Steal Things. garnered five total Grammy nominations for Mraz, including two wins – Best Male Pop Vocal Performance (for “Make It Mine”) and Best Pop Collaboration with Vocals (for “Lucky”). The album features the Mraz-penned “I’m Yours,” which remained on Billboard’s “Hot 100” chart longer than any other song in history, and was honored as the 2010 ASCAP Song of the Year at their Pop Music Awards. Last year, Mraz received two Teen Choice awards as well as the Songwriters Hall of Fame esteemed Hal David Starlight Award, presented to gifted songwriters who are making a significant impact in the music industry via their original songs.

A committed activist as well as an artist, Mraz received the 2009 Music Matters award from the Environmental Media Association to recognize his work increasing awareness of environmental issues and inspiring personal action on these issues. Named by Mother Nature Network as a top Farmer Under 40, Mraz tends to his avocado farm and surfs when at home in San Diego. He is currently at work on his fourth studio album to be released in 2011.
